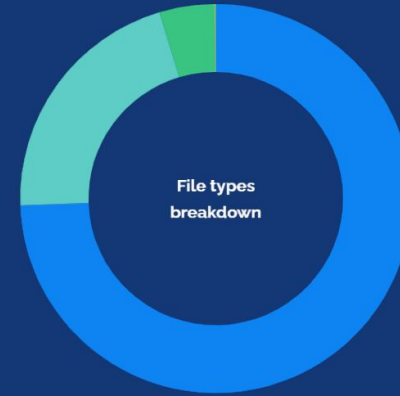

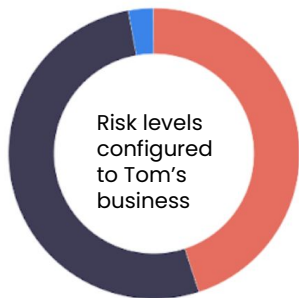

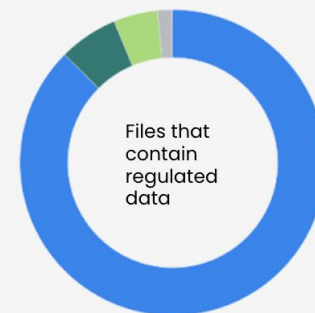

Recon offers Tom numerous ways to view risk intelligence. It provides views by file, and also sees into files to provide information at the data element level. Below are two file-centric risk views.



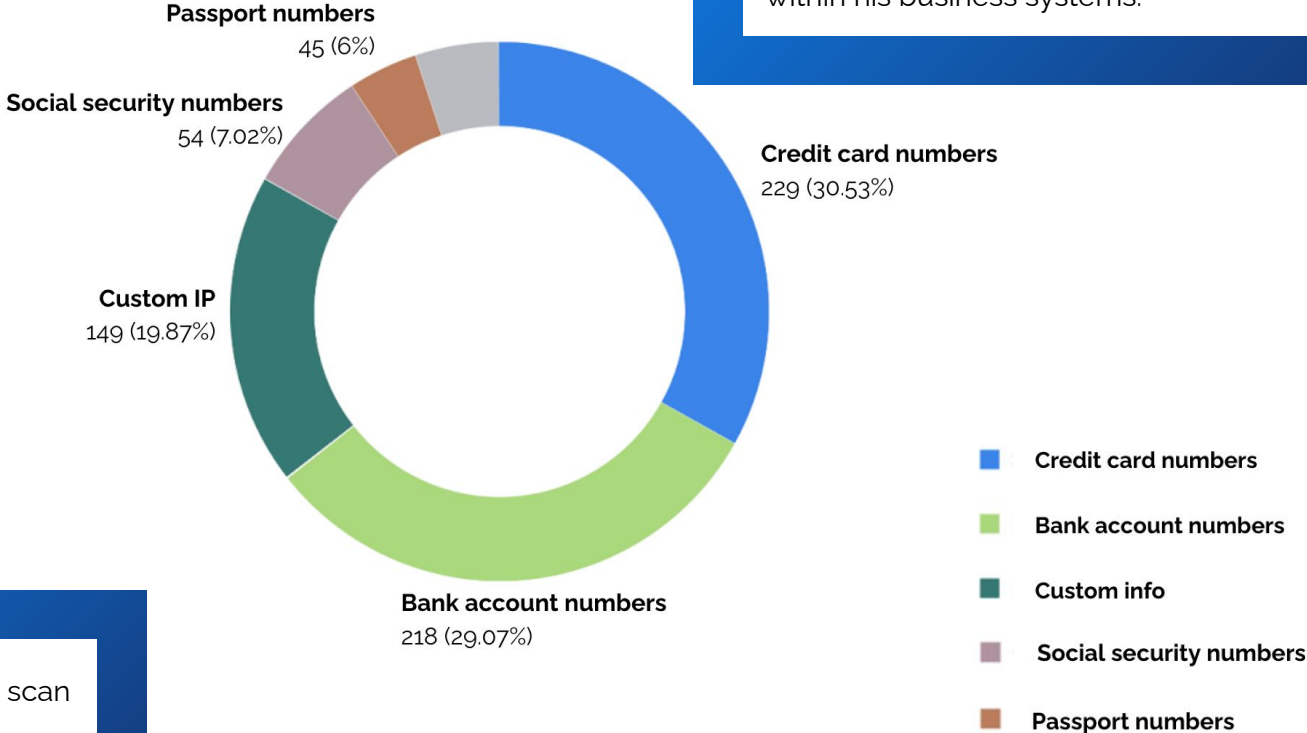
- High- 341 files

Data element risk view

Recon uniquely sees into files to scan individual data elements. This granularity enables novel functionality within the tool. It also provides Tom insight into the types of sensitive data within his business systems.



Tom was also able to use Recon to scan for his own proprietary data.

High-risk files

Whereas alternatives left Tom sorting through a data dump, in order to help Tom's team prioritize, Recon surfaces the files that contain the greatest risk.
